

## Richard J. Wilhelm

Mr. Wilhelm is a Vice President and Partner at Booz Allen Hamilton, where he provides services to the federal government's intelligence agencies, and leads the firm's Central Intelligence Agency and Office of the Director of National Intelligence businesses. He has also provided information security, infrastructure protection, and homeland security services to clients in the federal government and commercial institutions. In addition, he has performed client work for the White House, the Department of Defense, the Department of Homeland Security, civil agencies, and commercial banks and insurance companies. He currently serves on the Board of the National Association of the World Affairs Council of America.

Prior to joining Booz Allen Hamilton, he had a 29-year career in government as both a naval intelligence officer and civilian political appointee, serving as Executive Director for Intelligence Community Affairs and Director of the Intelligence Community Staff, the senior U.S. government official responsible for the nation's intelligence budget formulation, strategic planning, policy and program development. In the mid-90's, he was Vice President Gore's Senior White House advisor on a wide range of national security policy matters, including intelligence, covert action, terrorism, information warfare and information and infrastructure protection. He was a career naval officer with significant overseas command, staff and shipboard experience. He co-directed the Joint Intelligence Center for Iraq during DESERT STORM supporting the Secretary of Defense, the Chairman, Joint Chiefs of Staff, and combat commanders in the Persian Gulf and was instrumental in developing the target set for the air war which destroyed Iraq's command and control infrastructure. He was also the first Director, Information Warfare, at the National Security Agency. He has testified before Congress, was a member of two Defense Science Boards and a member of the Markle Task Force on National Security in the Information Age.

He has a 1968 BA in Russian Area Studies from Syracuse University, performed graduate work at Georgetown University, is a 1980 distinguished graduate of the Naval War College and graduated with distinction from the advanced Russian language course at the Defense Language Institute in 1971. He maintains a Top Secret clearance and is additionally cleared for special compartmented intelligence.
